

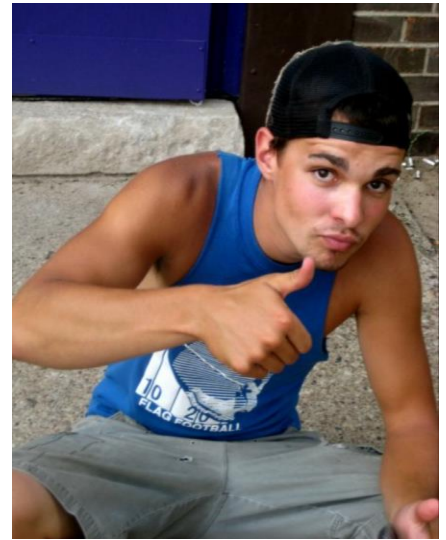
# Dan Zurawski Memorial Scholarship Fund

Dan was a sophomore attending UWSP when he drowned at Buck Lake in the summer of 2009. Dan truly touched the
